If not pre-entered, a \$5.00 fee will be added to each of the above.

Non-showing schooling fee - \$25.00.

HARD HATS MUST BE WORN WHILE MOUNTED.

The Judge's decision will be final.

All dogs must be on a leash at all times.

Entries MUST be paid at time of entry or covered by a signed check left with show secretary.

If payment is not made at the show, a processing fee of \$25.00 will be added.

CURRENT NEGATIVE COGGINS REQUIRED.

Return check fee is \$35.00.
